Conditions of Entry

Please read carefully the following conditions of entry which apply to all Yarra Valley Racing customers:

Refusal of Entry

For the comfort, safety and enjoyment of all patrons, Yarra Valley Racing management reserves the right to:

- Refuse entry to any persons deemed to be intoxicated and / or disorderly;
- Refuse entry to any unauthorised persons;
- Refuse entry of items which have the potential to cause injury or public nuisance (ie large flags / banners, musical instruments etc).

General Conditions

- Yarra Valley Racing reserves the right to inspect / search bags brought into or out of Yarra Valley Racing.
- Persons gaining unauthorised access to Yarra Valley Racing and / or the race track may be liable for prosecution.
- Patrons who cause a disturbance, or refuse to comply with requests made by Yarra Valley Racing staff will be evicted from the Racecourse.
- Pass-outs will not be issued.
- Alcoholic beverages cannot be taken into or out of the Racecourse by patrons.
- Smoking on the premises is only permitted in designated smoking areas and not within seating or enclosed areas.

- Customers wishing to bring personal items into Yarra Valley Racing do so at their own risk. Yarra Valley Racing will not be held responsible for any damages to, loss or theft of a patron's personal property.
- Shade structures or umbrellas may be brought into the Racecourse but may not be erected on the front lawn or other areas as advised.
- Unauthorised soliciting and customer surveying is not permitted.

Restricted / Prohibited Items

The following restricted / prohibited items are not permitted into Yarra Valley Racing:

- Glass or cans;
- Personal BBQ's;
- Pets
- Alcoholic beverages;
- Flares / Fireworks;
- Umbrellas
- Laser pointers;
- Knives or other dangerous weapons;

Liquor Licensing

"All persons entering Yarra Valley Racing are advised that:

- They are entering licensed premises;
- Intoxicated persons will not be permitted to enter;
- Persons in possession of liquor will not be permitted to enter;
- Checking procedures will apply to prevent persons possessing liquor from entering;
- Intoxicated persons will be removed from the premises;
- It is an offence for minors to purchase and consume liquor;
- It is an offence to purchase liquor for (or supply liquor to) minors;
- Persons supplying liquor to minors will be reported to the Police and penalties apply under the Liquor Act 1982."

Pre-purchased Drinks Packages (Corporate Marquees and Function Rooms)

- All pre-purchased drinks packages are from 15 minutes before the first local race to the jump of the last local race based on an 8 race program. If more than eight races are conducted the Pre-purchased drinks package will start 5 hours prior to the start of the last race.
- In line with Responsible Service of Alcohol best practice, Yarra Valley Racing reserves the right to refuse service to any person who is considered intoxicated. Clients are instructed that alcoholic beverages are not to be served to guests under the age of 18 years, or to guests in a state of intoxication. If a person is in breach of the liquor licensing laws they may be removed from the Racecourse.
- Behaviour – Guests are required to have regard for the amenity of the facilities and their enjoyment by all guests. Any breach of acceptable behavioural standards will result in removal of guests from the marquee area.

Proof of Age

- Patrons are advised that any person between the age of 18 – 25 years is required to wear a “Proof of Age” wristband should they wish to purchase and/or consume alcohol on course. Security will be conducting random checks throughout the day to ensure that patrons are correctly wrist banded.
- “Proof of Age” wristbands can be obtained from the information marquee located at the rear of the Main Grandstand.
- Patrons who are between the ages of 18 – 25 years who are consuming alcohol and do not have a wristband will be evicted from the course. Any patron who refuses to provide Proof of Age when requested by Security will be evicted from the course.

Cancellation Policy

If for any reason, a booking is cancelled the following conditions apply:

- More than 14 days prior to the event – 25% cancellation fee applies.
- Within 14 days of the event – non refundable.

If for any reason the race meeting is cancelled, the following conditions will apply:

- Cancellation of the meeting prior to the start of racing, the club will recover its costs and refund the balance to the customer.
- No refund is payable once racing commences.
